# Instructions Heavy Duty Leak Diverter

Remove all components from packaging, unfold and locate DRAIN CUPS. (There may be up to 3 DRAIN CUPS, depending on the size of the DIVERTER.) For shipping, the DRAIN CUPS are in an inverted position. Push up on the DRAIN CUP until it turns inside out. Now water can flow freely into CUP.

Repeat steps 4-5 for all other GROMMETS on DIVERTER. Do not tighten until all BUNGEEES have been secured.

Push black HOSE FITTING into bottom of DRAIN CUP until snug. Once inserted, tighten threaded ring to secure HOSE FITTING to DRAIN CUP. Do not over-tighten ring.

Once DIVERTER has been secured on all sides with BUNGEEES, slide CORD through hoop to tighten. Adjust until water flows freely toward DRAIN CUPS.

If your DIVERTER came with the optional QUICK CONNECT, separate the two pieces and attached the male end of the QUICK CONNECT into the HOSE FITTING. Attach female side onto HOSE and set to side. It is easier to install DIVERTER without the hose being attached.

When desired tightness is achieved, wrap CORD around hook fastener and pull to secure. This will prevent the BUNGEE CORD from slipping out of place. Repeat on all other BUNGEEES.

Attach BUNGEE HOOK to GROMMET on DIVERTER. Make sure DIVERTER faces down, away from drip (hose connection faces toward floor).

Attach the HOSE to DRAIN CUP (or reconnect QUICK CONNECT with hose already in place). Insert other end of hose into a bucket, drain or anything else that can contain the water coming down from DIVERTER. Monitor the movement of water, so overflow or pooling on floor doesn't occur.

Secure opposite HOOK to a sturdy beam, pipe, hook or object that can hold the weight of the DIVERTER and any water that may pool inside.\* Bungee's are fully Adjustable from six inches up to nine feet.

GO GRAILEY HEAVY DUTY LEAK DIVERTERS are transparent for observing blockages near the DRAIN CUP or any pooling water. If you see that the water is not flowing freely, adjust BUNGEEES so water flows into DRAIN CUP and down hose. Place included CAPS onto any unused DRAIN CUPS.
